

# NEED SOME HELP...

## SIMPLIFIED FORMULA FOR SELECTING CONCERT BAND REPERTOIRE

### A NOTE FROM THE CONDUCTOR:

I can't even count how many times I have been asked over the years to clarify my process for selecting repertoire for any ensemble I conduct. First of all, let me assure you, the process is much more involved than selecting a number of pieces 'I want to play'. It usually takes months of planning to assemble a collection of works that I feel both complement each other and which meet the necessary criteria for any particular season.

The issue, I suppose, has been that the process isn't transparent. So I am going to try and give you a better idea of how these decisions are made. Let me know if you have any further questions.

#### THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND WHEN SELECTING REPERTOIRE...

- Limit of Selections in Folder -8 max... 5-6 preferred (Mass Band selections are an exception to this count)
- How long will it take the ensemble to prepare a selection for performance? (4 or 8 months)
- Is there a healthy mixture of upbeat and lyrical works?
- Does the instrumentation fit with our ensemble? (Does it require instruments we don't have, or have enough of?)
- Does the piece highlight our stronger or our weaker sections in the band? (does it require a soloist?)
- Is there something to challenge the group, as well as some easier/enjoyable works?
- WILL THE BAND FIND SUCCESS AND ACCOMPLISHMENT IN LEARNING THIS PIECE?
