GREGORY IRVINE, a native of Nova Scotia, was Principal Tubaist of the Hamilton (Ontario) Philharmonic Orchestra for eleven years. During that time he also performed with ensembles such as the Toronto Philharmonic, Toronto Pops, and CJRT Orchestras. He has performed extensively as a tuba soloist, and in chamber ensembles including the Royal Brass of the Hamilton Philharmonic, and the Aeolos Brass Quintet, which toured throughout Canada during the 1980s. Dr. Irvine has studied his instrument with some of the finest and best-known tuba players in the world. Currently Gregory is a professor of brass at the University of Prince Edward Island.



JOBEBY WILSON, tubist, has entertained audiences all over the world with his charismatically unique style. At the age of 17 he flew to Chicago to join the Cavaliers Drum and Bugle Corps. After completing his Bachelor of Music at the University of Oklahoma under Ted L. Cox, the proud "Sooner" moved northeast to refine his skills under the legendary Chester Schmitz of the Boston Symphony Orchestra. In 2001, Jobey earned his Master's degree from New England Conservatory and has since served as principal tubist of the Lexington Symphony.

Wilson is an Artist Faculty in the University of Southern Maine Music, an Adjunct Professor of Music/Low Brass at Boston College and the Low Brass and Chamber Music Coach for the Boston Youth Symphony Orchestras.
